| Document Number     | Document Name   | Description   |

| T4                  | Employment Income   | Used for employees only   |
| T4A                 | Self-Employment (Sub-Contractors) / Professional or Business Activity | Used for any kind of business-like Uber, Skip, Doordash etc. or if you have received any money for your professional activities   |
| T4E                 | EI Benefits   | Used for money earned from Service Canada for unemployment period, unemployed maternity / paternity leave, sick leave, etc.   |
| T5                  | Dividend Declared / Investment Income                                 | Earned income from your investment in other companies, banks, or interest income.   |
| T2200               | Employment Expenses   | If your employer gives you consent for the expenses that you paid and were not reimbursed.  |
| T2201               | Disability Tax Credit   | Please check the DTC form.  |
| T2202               | Tuition Fee   | Used to claim for your tuition expenses paid to colleges, universities and post graduate institutional organization. You can download this form from your school's account. |
